I blow all the water lines out with compressed air and make sure to completely drain all lines. If you use this method blow the lines out until no more water comes out of any of the lines. I don't like to use the RV antifreeze in the lines or water heater, I only use it in the gray and black tanks. The system you use is entirely personal preference.
